1994 Truchard Chardonnay Wild Burgundian aromas of earth, truffle, and sulfides. Big, sweet and rich; a large-scaled chardonnay with great immediate appeal. Has just enough acidity to maintain its shape. Long, surprisingly fresh finish. An impressive wine for early consumption. 91 pts. International Wine Cellar. (May/June '96)

1994 Truchard Merlot Excellent deep red-ruby to the rim. Flamboyant aromas of spicy cherry, chocolate and cedary oak. Rich and sweet but bright acids give the wine good flavor definition; not particularly fat, but there's excellent spicy fruit. Focused if not especially complex. Finishes quite long, with fine tannins and notes of vanilla and spicy oak. 89 pts. International Wine Cellar. (May/June '96)

1992 Truchard Cabernet Sauvingnon Excellent ruby-red. Flamboyant, perfumed nose of cassis, roasted game, iron, tobacco and minerals. Dense but supple, with almost syrah-like wild berry flavor and considerable palate impact. Strong iron-like soil tones and good acid structure. Very long finish, with fine, tongue-dusting tannins. Fascinating wine. 90pts. International Wine Cellar. (May/June '96)
