FIRST RELEASES. Three full flavored Zins. The Aida (300 cases), from a vineyard planted in 1973, is our favorite. It is fleshy, ripe, and fairly rich, with good texture and balance, and evident oak. The Hayne (vineyard planted 1908) bottling is both richer and more intense (15.8% alcohol, 300 cases), with peppery overtones and some heat on the finish. The Moore Earthquake Vineyard (planted 1906, 300 cases) is spicy, toasty, and medium rich, with some tannin on the finish. [1996-2000] 707.963.0940
