Wonderful deep dark red in the glass. The nose has a nice combination of cranberry, dark cherry, raisin and a hint of tar. Traditional jammy Zin flavors of dark berries with vanilla, cedar, plum and mild spices. There is a mysterious Bordeaux wine aroma when first opened, which wasn't distracting at all. This wine finishes dry and delicately spicy. Drink this now without any regrets or age it a few years for a more mellow flavor. This is not an overly sweet or pumped up spicy Zinfandel. It is a very classy and beautifully made wine that the person who has sworn off of Zin would really enjoy. And so did I.

Truchard Vineyards produces the only Zinfandel from Napa Carneros fruit. This wine is a great buy at \$25 US per bottle
